Students will not be able to join us in September if this form is not completed.

Tuesday 3 September

8.45 am – 10 am: Arrival at the main Montpelier School site on Cheltenham Road (blue doors) for registration from 8.45 am and a Welcome Assembly starting at 9 am by the V6 Sixth Form Team.

10 am – 11 am: Meet your mentor session with sixth form mentors and members of the Head Student Team.

11 am - 11.20 am: Break – please bring drinks/snacks with you.

11.20 am - 12.05 pm: Welcome Day Session 1: Carousel sessions: either tours of the site, Study Skills or Mental Fitness; these are designed to help you prepare for your sixth form experience. Students will complete all three sessions during the day.

12.10 pm - 12.55 pm: Welcome Day Session 2: Students will take an additional session from either tour of the site, Study Skills or Mental Fitness.

1 pm - 1.45 pm: Welcome Day Session 3: Students will take their final session from either tour of the site, Study Skills or Mental Fitness.

1.45 pm Departure from the sixth form site unless wishing to attend optional 1:1 meeting with sixth form team

1.45 pm – 3 pm: Optional drop-in student meetings in the Common Room with V6 Team regarding any issues or questions students might have, including course change requests. Students not wishing to attend are free to leave the site at 1.45 pm. Parents/carers can also request an optional online meeting via Microsoft Teams with their child's mentor to discuss any issues. 8.35 am - 10 am: Time with sixth form mentors (rooms will be confirmed on Tuesday) and preparation for the start of term activities. Students receive their timetables.
